

Frisbee Golf

Materials: Frisbee for each student, native plant fieldbooks, colored tape or ribbon

1. Students are split into teams of less than eight.
2. Teacher sets boundaries of the playing field
3. Each student is to locate a native plant identify it using the fieldbook, and find three things about that plant to share. They then mark the plant with the ribbon
4. When all students have completed their assignment, they will return to center of playing field.
5. Choosing the closest marked plant, students take turns throwing their Frisbees, trying to hit the marked plant with as few throws as possible.
6. All students will tally the number of throws it took to reach the target.
7. The student will then tell what his plant is and his three items about the plant.
8. The next closest marked plant is identified and play continues until all students have had a chance to tell about their plant.
9. Students with the fewest number of throws are the winners of the game.
